Service of Remembrance

Rev Lis Stenhouse led a well attended and moving service in the Village Hall, and later outside at the War Memorial, where a beautiful poppy tribute had been installed. The names of the fallen from the local communities were read aloud by Lis and wreaths laid, followed by a two minute silence and The Last Post.





The Poppy Tribute

Following the installation of new pavements around the Village Hall, our local Bloom group, Crook and Drum Growing Together, has worked hard to tidy up the verges, create new borders, plant bulbs and flowers, and laid new gravel stones at the War Memorial. During a planning session, the Bloom group discussed planting poppies around the memorial, which would flower during the summer. This sparked an idea for Remembrance Day and the possibility of draping a net from the memorial stone with knitted and crocheted poppies attached. Members of the Fossoway Creative Crafting group were asked if they could develop this idea and many of you will have seen the spectacular result of all their efforts. In just a few weeks, around 150 poppies were handmade by the Crafting group then carefully sewn onto netting. This Remembrance Day tribute has been very well received and appreciated in the Fossoway community and beyond. The Crafting group have agreed to continue with an annual display and would welcome newcomers who would like to be involved. 
